Instructions regarding Master of Public Health (MPH) Entrance Exam 2026-27

- ❖ An email has been sent to all provisionally eligible candidates on their registered email addresses, based on the information provided in their application forms. Candidates are advised to regularly check their email for further communication and updates.
- ❖ The MPH Entrance Examination will be conducted in **offline mode** at the National Institute of Public Health Training & Research (NIPHTR), Panvel Campus. Eligible candidates are required to appear for the examination in person.
- ❖ Candidates will be shortlisted on the basis of merit, determined by the marks obtained in the entrance examination, subject to fulfilment of the prescribed eligibility criteria and approval of admissions by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (MUHS), Nashik.
- ❖ All candidates must report to the examination venue at least **two hours prior** to the commencement of the examination. Candidates shall bear their own travel and related expenses for attending the examination. The details of the Entrance exam are scheduled as follows:

Note to Candidates:

1. Candidates must ensure that they fulfil all eligibility criteria prescribed in the admission notification before appearing for the entrance examination. The information furnished in the online application form and supporting documents must be complete, accurate, and authentic.
2. Submission of false, misleading, fabricated, or incomplete information at any stage of the admission process shall result in immediate disqualification of candidature. Such cases may also attract appropriate legal and disciplinary action as per the applicable rules and regulations.
3. Candidates are further informed that merely qualifying in the entrance examination does not confer any right to admission. Admission shall be granted only to those candidates who satisfy all eligibility requirements and complete the admission process as prescribed by the Institute and MUHS, Nashik.
4. If, at any stage of the admission process, it is found that a candidate does not meet the prescribed eligibility criteria or has furnished incorrect information, the candidature shall be cancelled forthwith, and any claim for admission shall stand forfeited.
5. The decision of the National Institute of Public Health Training & Research (NIPHTR) regarding eligibility, selection, and admission shall be final and binding. NIPHTR reserves the right to cancel candidature and take appropriate action in accordance with the applicable rules.
