About the Institute

The National Institute of Public Health Training and Research (NIPHTR) was established in June 1957 under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. It is one of the pioneering Central Training Institutes (C.T.I.) conducting in-service training for medical and paramedical personnel throughout the country in key health issues to enhance their knowledge and skills for better delivery of healthcare services to attain Universal Health Coverage and achieve Sustainable Development Goals 2030 (SDG'S)

Master of Public Health -

MPH is an intensive two-year course designed to provide a grounding in Public Health to strengthen each learner's knowledge and skills contributing to the development of a cadre of public health professionals. It has been designed with an inherent recognition that individuals admitted to this program have prior and current experience in the health sector. The program is divided into classroom-based coursework and field-based practical experience in Public Health. This course is a professional course, approved by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, and affiliated to Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (MUHS) Nashik. It is appropriate for those who want to pursue a career in the area of Public Health. The course is designed based on the latest international evidence and standards in Public Health.

Objectives

4. Financial planning and management skills for implementing public health programs in the country.
5. Leadership skills.

Eligibility Criteria

All Health Science Graduates i.e. (MBBS/BDS/BAMS/BHMS/BUMS/BPTh/BPO/BOTH/BASLP/PBBS (Nursing) / B. Sc. Nursing), B.Sc. (Paramedical Technology) OR Health Science Degree of any Statutory University.

(Note:1) Those Students who are doing internships are eligible for entrance examination, but they have to submit an Internship Completion Certificate along with other documents at the time of admission.

(Note:2) In-service candidates (Govt. / Private) fulfilling the above criteria have to submit the NOC of the concerned authority at the time of admission.

Information for Candidates:

1. Applications are to be submitted in a prescribed application form (available on the NIPHTR Website - <https://www.niphtr.mohfw.gov.in>).
2. An Entrance Examination of candidates will be conducted at NIPHTR, Mumbai. Communication for the entrance exam will be done by email only. Selection of the candidates will be based on the merit list drawn as per the entrance exam.
3. An Entrance Exam will be scheduled on 25th June 2026 (tentatively), and the confirmation of the date of the examination will be provided by email only.
4. No TA/DA will be provided for appearing for the Entrance Examination.
5. The institute has limited boarding & lodging facilities on both campuses for the students, which may be provided subject to availability and as per the decision of the competent authority.

6. The students availing of boarding & lodging facilities will need to pay hostel & mess charges as applied.
7. NIPHTR, Mumbai reserves the right to incorporate changes in course content, duration, fees, and the number of seats & may cancel the proposed schedule dates without assigning any reason & without notice.
8. The last date for submission of applications for the course is **24th May 2026**.
9. Applications should be sent online or by registered post to the Director, National Institute of Public Health Training and Research, 332, S. V. P. Road, Girgaon, Khetwadi, Mumbai - 400 004 to reach on or **before 24th May 2026**.

Note: -

- Candidate having Caste/Tribe Validity & Non-Creamy Layer certificate shall be included in the respective Category.
- Candidate not having Caste/Tribe Validity/Non-Creamy Layer certificate shall be treated as general /open category.

Selection process:

- a. It will be based on the merit list as per the entrance exam.
- b. Reservation criteria will be followed as per the Government of India norms.

1. Scheme of Entrance Examination: -

- Objective Type Screening test will be conducted to shortlist the applicants
- Syllabus & Rules for Entrance Examination.
Multiple choice questions (M.C.Q.) shall be based on the Basic Concepts of health and disease, Nutrition, National health policies, health programs, General Knowledge, Reasoning, language proficiency, communication etc.
- The candidate will be required to mark the correct answer with a black/blue ballpoint pen in the given question.
- Each correct answer will be given two marks. There shall be no negative marking.
- Scratching, overwriting, and multiple answers will be considered as wrong answers and no marks will be allotted to them.

2. Preparation of Merit list & selection of candidates: -

A merit list shall be prepared of those candidates appearing for the Entrance Examination. The said merit list shall be used for the process of provisional admission.

In case of equal marks in the Entrance Test the following procedure shall be adopted for deciding the merit.

- a. First level:- The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentages up to 2 decimal points) at HSC.
 - b. Second Level:- The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentages up to 2 decimal points) at SSC
 - c. Third Level: - If the tie still persists then an older candidate will be preferred over the younger candidate.
3. The candidate will be admitted provisionally subject to the submission of all original documents and two sets of attested copies of the same in support of the claim made in the application form i.e. Caste Certificate, Caste Validity Certificate, and non-creamy layer certificate etc.
 4. All admissions will be provisional till final Enrollment by MUHS Nashik.

Attendance: -

80% attendance is compulsory failing which students will not be allowed to appear for the examinations.

A medical certificate is necessary if absence is due to illness.

Stipend: - No stipend will be provided for this course.
