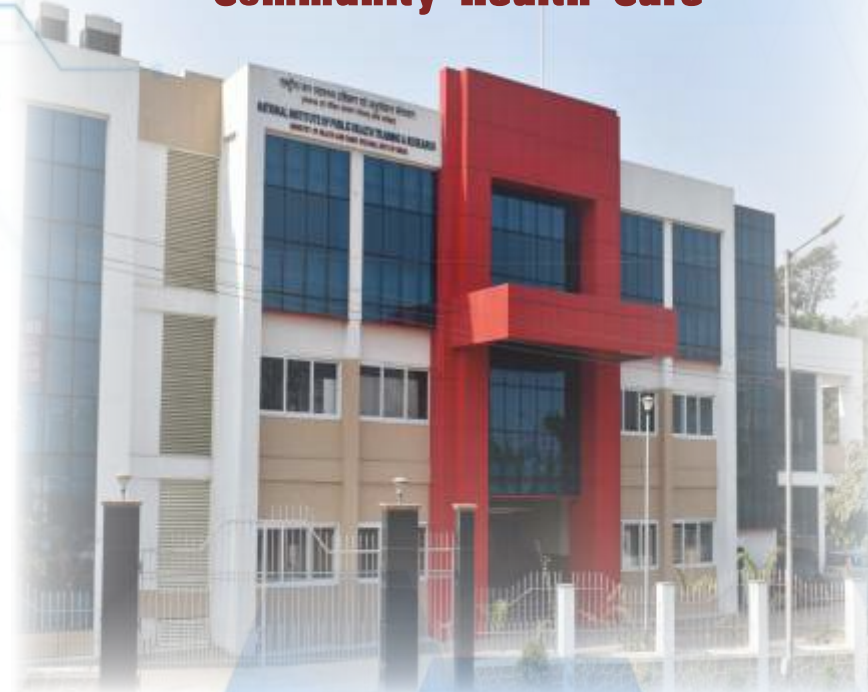

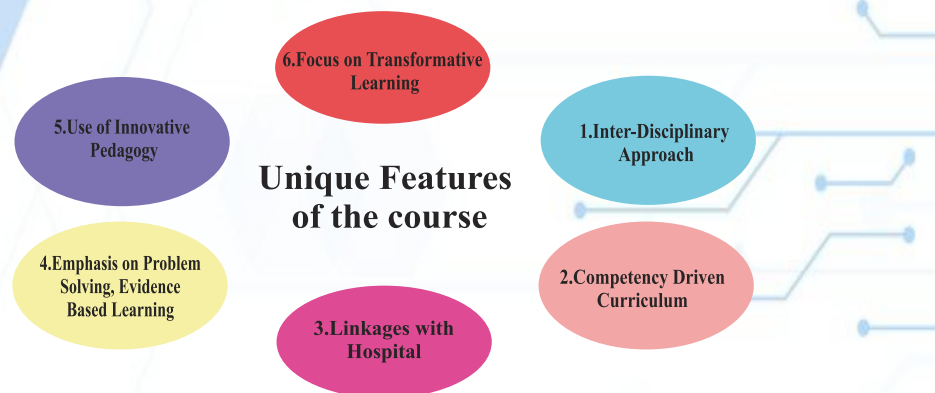

BACKGROUND OF INSTITUTE

National Institute of Public Health Training and Research (NIPHTR) was established in June 1957 under Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. It is one of the pioneering Central Training Institutes (C.T.I.) conducting in-service training for medical and paramedical personnel in important health issues to enhance their knowledge and skills for better delivery of health care services to attain Universal health Coverage and achieve Sustainable Development Goals (SDG'S).



PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

Post Graduate Diploma in Community Health Care (PGDCHC) course is designed to develop skilled Mid – level health care providers in the field of essential health care and public health services. Ministry of Health & Family Welfare in collaboration with Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) has started a “Bridge Programme” to develop a pool of Mid-level health care providers to strengthen sub-centres and renamed as Health & Wellness Centres. PGDCHC curriculum which was reviewed and revised on completion of its 10 years also includes topic which are part of the Bridge Programme. PGDCHC course creates a pool of Mid-level health care providers to deliver Comprehensive Primary Health Care for better implementation of National Health Programmes to achieve Sustainable Development Goals 2030

OBJECTIVES

- 1.Explain concepts of basic health sciences, Nutrition and allied sciences in causation of diseases.
- 2.Identify socio-cultural and psychological factors influencing health behaviour and apply skills of group dynamics and community organisation for health promotion.
- 3.Explain Health infrastructure and Health care delivery system in India and interpret various reforms and changing trends in healthcare delivery system.
- 4.Describe principles of epidemiology for disease causation, prevention, control and screening for diseases.
- 5.List National Health Programmes under National Health Mission (NHM) and explain its component and

state National Health policies-goals, directions, approaches, priorities and strategies.

- 6.Demonstrate skills in package of services for preventive, promotive and basic curative services for provision of comprehensive primary health care to solve local health problems, emergencies and provide referral services.
- 7.Apply advanced technologies for sanitation, environmental hygiene, safe drinking water supply and work in collaboration with Village Health Nutrition Sanitation Committee.

8.Display Supervisory, Monitoring and Managerial abilities for effective implementation of various health programmes in the community.

9.Demonstrate skills in modern techniques of Communication, Counselling and organisation of health promotion interventions in the community.

10.Apply scientifically sound Research methods, Statistics and Health Management Information System for community need assessment and plan suitable Health interventions.
